Terms of the agreement

Sale conditions

It is understood that at the time of this sale, this dog is considered to be representative of his/her breed and is structurally and temperamentally suited as a companion, performance and/or obedience dog. This dog has received all appropriate vaccinations and is to the best of the seller's knowledge, healthy at the time of the sale. Based on genetic testing and knowledge of the health and background of breeding stock, the breeder believes the dog, and the sire and the dam of the dog, to be free of hereditary defects. The sheltie's registered name shall begin with ``Selection``.

It is recommended that the buyer have the animal examined by a reputable, licensed veterinarian during the first 14 days. After 14 days, the breeder will no way be responsible of any diseases, internal or external parasites or nutritional neglect.

This puppy is guaranteed for three years after the receipt of purchase of the animal to be free of any hereditary and congenital defects. The breeder will replace the sheltie of equal quality when one will be available if the puppy's condition is such that euthanasia is recommended. Medical proof stating the diagnosis causing the defect and a proof of euthanasia must be provided to Selection Shelties by a certified veterinarian. All medical cost are the responsibility of the buyer.

This puppy is guaranteed for three years after the receipt of purchase of the animal for serious temperament problems. The buyer agrees to have the dog examined by a canine behavior specialist at the buyer's expense. If the specialist determines that the temperament flaw is more likely genetic in nature, the buyer must return the dog to the breeder. Temperament proof stating the diagnosis must be provided to Selection Shelties. The breeder will replace the sheltie of equal quality when one will be available. If the specialist determines that the dog's temperament difficulties are a result of environmental factors, no replacement will be given.

Buyer has been advised and understands the puppy is being sold on non breeding agreement, which means any puppies produced by this sheltie cannot be registered with Canadian Kennel Club. This sheltie is not to be used for breeding.

If at any time the buyer cannot keep this dog, is unable, unwilling to care or for any other reason chooses to part with this dog, the breeder will have the first right of refusal to have the dog back. This sheltie may be returned to the breeder at any time of his/her natural life, for any reason, and the breeder will happily accept his/her return.

This guarantee is void if the dog has been resold.

The buyer agrees to provide appropriate food, water, shelter and veterinary care throughout the lifetime of the dog.

Both buyer and seller have read the above contract and understand and agree to all the conditions stated herein.
